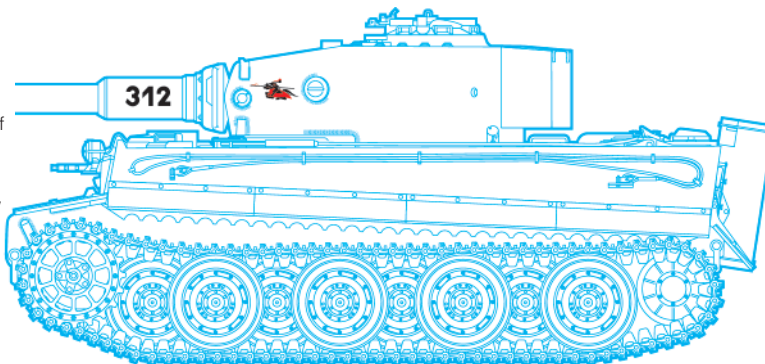
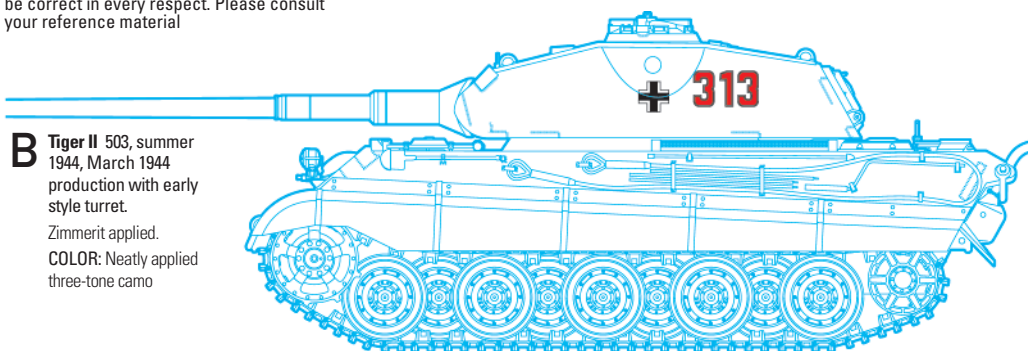


**A Tiger I** of 505, February 1944 production. First production to include steel wheels.

Zimmerit coating applied. Tactical numbers applied to thickest part of the gun barrel. There is some speculation that the area beneath the tactical number was painted yellow, but it may also be a 'clean' patch of dark yellow base paint.  
**COLOR:** overall dark yellow with neatly applied bands of dark red brown.

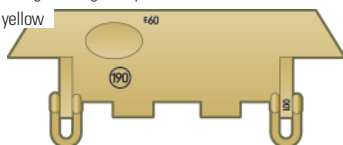


**B Tiger II** 503, summer 1944, March 1944 production with early style turret.

Zimmerit applied.  
**COLOR:** Neatly applied three-tone camo

**C Tiger II prototype** produced in November 1943.

No Zimmerit coating. Flat, Tiger I style fenders.  
**COLOR:** Dark yellow



**D Tunisian Tiger I**, 501, February/March 1943 production. 7th company of the 10th panzer division's panzer regiment 7 (formerly of the 1st company of the 501).

Markings depict a tank with all the early features (lowered lights, rear hull spare tracks and early exhaust covers) that transitioned to the 10th PzDiv with these features in tact and new coat of Olive drab paint.

No Zimmerit coating.

Note: 'Norbert' was actually a former 2nd company vehicle rather than the earlier tank (October 1942 production) depicted in Ampersand's Modeler's Guide to the Tiger Tank. The model is actually based on a vehicle of the 1st company (with all 1st company modifications still in place), number 732. If you wish, this exact tank can be recreated using the Archer's large red and white number sheet 35113 and the Tiger battalion sheet 35136.
